Location

Traveling to and from Port Charlotte/North Port is easy from almost anywhere in the country. Three interchanges on I-75 connect the community to Southwest Florida International Airport in Fort Myers (approximately 42 miles from I-75 Exit 170). This \$438 million terminal was the nation's newest and most state-of-the-art international airport when it opened in late 2005.





More than 7,000,000 passengers were served by the airport in 2005.



28 gates offer non-stop service to 41 major airports.




Beaches

Beautiful, white sand beaches are synonymous with Florida. Port Charlotte/North Port residents are fortunate to have miles and miles of uncrowded public beaches along the calm and warm waters of the Gulf of Mexico. There are 12 named beaches within 25 miles of what is commonly considered "the town center" of Port Charlotte/North Port (the intersection of US 41 and State Road 776).

Schools

Much of the explosive growth in Port Charlotte/
North Port is the result of younger families moving in.
As of mid 2006 there were 14 public elementary,
middle and high schools open and three more
schools either under construction or scheduled to
open before classes begin in 2010. The construction
cost of the new schools is estimated at almost
\$75 million.

Port Charlotte/North Port residents sleep well at night knowing that modern hospitals and health care professionals serve the community. There are currently two major hospitals with a total of 468 beds and over 300 physicians and surgeons in Port Charlotte/North Port. There are four other hospitals within 22 miles of what is considered "the town center" of Port Charlotte/North Port (the intersection of US 41 and State Road 776).
